The Grayson County Children's Advocacy Center would like to invite you, your business, your church, and your family to be a part of recognizing April as Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention Month. Here's how:

Show Us Your Blue! – Tie Blue Ribbons around your trees or signs, post the slogan “It’s Everyone’s Job to Protect Children” or “No Excuse for Child Abuse” on your signs, social media, or church bulletins, or put our blue car magnets on your vehicle during the month of April. Get our blue shirts and wear them every Friday and/or on April 5 (Go Blue Day in Texas). Snap photos in blue so we can see how you are showing your blue! We’re happy to share on our Facebook page. Sign up for a free class – Sign up for one of our free prevention classes during the month and learn how to recognize and report child abuse.
