The Grayson County Children's Advocacy Center would like to invite your school district to be a part of recognizing April as Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention Month. Here's how:

Show Us Your Blue! – Tie Blue Ribbons around your school, post the slogans “See the Signs of Child Abuse 2020” or “No Excuse for Child Abuse” on your indoor and outdoor marquee signs, or in school newsletters for the month of April. Get our blue shirts for everyone at your school and wear them every Friday in April but especially on April 3rd (Go Blue Day in Texas). Snap photos of your school in blue so we can see how you are showing your blue! We're happy to share on our Facebook page and tag you! See the next page for information on ordering shirts.

Learn--Sign up for a free class – Sign up for one of our free prevention classes during the month and learn how to recognize and report abuse. We will hold classes at the THF Community Room on April 8th from 11:00am-1:00pm and April 21st from 6:00-8:00pm. We'd be happy to come to your school and train all of your staff.
